Dear Dr. Soin,

I am writing to ask that the Ohio Medical Board review or refer for review the incidence of post-abortion complications related to the use of mifepristone (RU-486) and likely illegal non-disclosure under the law.

As you are likely aware, ORC 2912.123 governs the unlawful distribution of the abortion-inducing drug, mifepristone (RU-486). One of the requirements of that law is that any physician who prescribes an abortion-inducing drug and whose patient experiences “during or after the use an incomplete abortion, severe bleeding, or an adverse reaction to the RU-486 (mifepristone) or is hospitalized, receives a transfusion, or experiences any other serious event, the physician promptly must provide a written report of the incomplete abortion, severe bleeding, adverse reaction, hospitalization, transfusion, or serious event to the state medical board.” Failing to make such a report carries the statutory penalty of a fourth degree felony, unless the individual has been previously found guilty of other listed infractions, which would increase the felony to a third degree felony. In addition, the statute provides for professional sanctions to be taken against a licensed person. It is under this provision that I am writing to you today. The referenced reports are collected and maintained by the Ohio Medical Board and are commonly called “RU-486 Event Reports.”

As a pro-life organization in Ohio, we regularly review Ohio’s available public records relating to abortion and use them to identify trends, to inform the public of health and safety and legal concerns at local clinics, and to assist in providing the public with a thorough understanding of the risks related to induced abortion. Following a recent public records request to your office for the RU-486 Reports from 2012 to the present, our team observed that of the hundreds of reports spanning a five-year time period from 2011 to 2017, the Ohio Medical Board collected reports from a number of physicians and five distinct ambulatory surgical facilities providing abortion services. The reporting clinics were: Planned Parenthood on Rockside Road in Cleveland, Preterm in Cleveland, Planned Parenthood in Columbus, Planned Parenthood in Cincinnati, and the NEO Women’s Clinic in Cuyahoga Falls.

When looking at these reports, something extraordinary became evident. There are numerous licensed ambulatory surgical facilities performing (or at least advertising) RU-486 abortions in Ohio as well as several stand-alone clinics that distribute the medical abortion pill. However, only five clinics have reported RU-486 Event reports to the Ohio Medical Board. Two operating clinics, however, did not make any reports: Capital Care Network of Toledo and Founder’s Women’s Health Center in Columbus. This is remarkable because Capital Care Network of Toledo and Founder’s Women’s Health Center, along with the now closed Capital Care Network of Cuyahoga Falls and Capital Care Network of Columbus, are (or were) all under the ownership and/or management of the same individual or company: T&S Management and Terrie Hubbard.

While, one might say that it is possible that either these clinics did not provide the medical abortion pill or had so few women taking them that they had no failures to report, their own websites undermine that claim. Current versions of the website for both Capital Care Network of Toledo¹ and Founder's Women's Health² cite a five to seven percent failure rate at their clinics.

Furthermore, cached versions of the clinics' websites³ between 2011 and 2015 included the following language, "Studies have shown that non-surgical abortion using Mifeprex® is highly effective. Worldwide, millions of women have successfully used mifepristone for many years. There is a 5-7% chance that this abortion method will fail, making it necessary for the woman to return for a surgical abortion (at no additional charge). We have had 95% effectiveness with Mifeprex® and misoprostol." We used the Library of Congress' Internet archival system to verify this language on the website in each of 2011, 2012, 2013, 2014, and 2015.

In the course of our review into these matters, we also observed that while the management of the clinics appears to be under T&S Management, the business and ambulatory surgical facility license for Founder's Women's Health Center is actually held as a trade name for Downtown Gynecologists, a licensed (medical) professional association of Dr. Harley Blank, Dr. Karl Schaffer, and retired Dr. Robert Chosy. The business license for Downtown Gynecologists was cancelled in October of 2016 due to the partners' failure to file a biennial report of professional association⁴. It was not the first such cancellation of the business. However, we observed that Dr. Chosy has retired from the practice of medicine and that his license to practice medicine expired in 2009. We are of the understanding that a retired physician who enjoys emeritus status is not considered licensed to practice medicine and ineligible to be a member of a licensed professional association, making it somewhat concerning that he maintained a membership interest in the association, as certified⁵ by at least one of his partners, Dr. Harley Blank and other clinic management between 2010 and 2014.

I am attaching to this letter supporting documentation and asking that the Ohio State Medical Board please review the cited clinic records to determine if the clinics or the physicians at the clinics have failed to comply with Ohio law and that the appropriate referrals be made for licensure sanctions or criminal prosecution. I would also request that, to the extent you are able, you identify those other clinics providing the medical abortion pill to ensure that they are properly reporting any complications.

ATTACHMENT 1

WHAT IS A MEDICAL ABORTION ?

This method uses oral medications to terminate an early pregnancy, instead of surgery. It consists of two different types of pills: **Mifeprex™** (<http://www.fda.gov/downloads/Drugs/DrugSafety/ucm088643.pdf>) and **Misoprostol** (<http://www.webmd.com/women/mifepristone-and-misoprostol-for-abortion>).

When paired together, these two medications are a safe and effective way to end an early pregnancy (less than 8 weeks 6 days as determined by ultrasound).

WHAT IS MIFEPREX ?

Mifeprex™ (<http://earlyoptionpill.com/>) (also known as RU-486 or mifepristone) is a progesterone-receptor antagonist. That's just a fancy way of saying it blocks the hormone that's necessary for a pregnancy to grow. This medication is given to the patient by a doctor on Day 1 (Appointment #2).

WHAT IS MISOPROS TOL?

Misoprostol (also called Cytotec™) causes the uterus to contract and expel the pregnancy (similar to a miscarriage), usually within 48 hours of taking medication. During this time, you will have bleeding, cramping, and flu-like symptoms.

CAN I GET THESE PILLS FROM MY FAMILY DOCTOR?

Unfortunately, these medications are **not** available through pharmacies or at most regular doctor's offices. **Mifeprex** and **Misoprostol** are different from birth control pills or emergency contraception pills (Plan B). Ohio has strict regulations when it comes to dispensing medical abortion medications. Our staff has received specific training to guide you through this 2-visit process and phone follow-ups.

WHAT ARE THE POSSIBLE RISKS?

Although cramping and bleeding are an expected part of ending a pregnancy, in rare instances, serious and potentially life-threatening bleeding, infections, or other problems can occur

following a miscarriage, medical abortion, or childbirth. Prompt medical attention is needed in these circumstances.

Serious infection has resulted in death in a very small number of cases; in most of these cases misoprostol was used in the vagina. **There is no information that use of Mifeprex and misoprostol caused these deaths.**

At Capital Care Network, we **do not** administer misoprostol vaginally. **Our patients are instructed to take misoprostol orally. We also provide all patients with antibiotics to reduce the risk of infection.** These infections are almost always caused by an organism that is already present in your body, and are not due to an organism introduced at the time of your abortion.

If you are a current patient at our clinic and you are worried about any side effects or symptoms you are experiencing, please call the **24-hour emergency number** that was provided to you during your first appointment.

WHEN CAN I RESUME MY BIRTH CONTROL REGIMEN?

You can resume birth control the Sunday after your procedure. If you are interested in birth control, a nurse can go over your options with you in the Recovery Room after your abortion procedure.

We can provide you with a prescription for oral contraception or vaginal rings, which you can take to your pharmacy to get it filled.

You'll have cramping and bleeding, and the pregnancy will be expelled. The process is usually completed within 24 hours.

Three weeks after taking Mifeprex®, you will take a pregnancy test to determine whether the abortion has been completed. If the results are positive or faint positive you will need to come in for a follow up. During this visit we will perform an ultrasound to determine whether or not you are still pregnant. An advocate will go over your options which include a surgical abortion to end the pregnancy.

Studies have shown that non-surgical abortion using Mifeprex® is highly effective. Worldwide, millions of women have successfully used mifepristone for many years. There is a 5-7% chance that this abortion method will fail, making it necessary for the woman to return for a surgical abortion (at no additional charge). **We have had 95% effectiveness with Mifeprex® and misoprostol.**

Symptoms and Side Effects

Most women will experience cramping and bleeding, which usually means that the method is working. Bleeding may be similar to, or greater than, a normal heavy period. You may see blood clots and tissue that come from the uterus. This is an expected part of ending the pregnancy. Bleeding or spotting will usually last an average of 9 to 16 days and may last for up to 30 days. In rare cases (1 woman in 100), bleeding can be very heavy and may need to be stopped by a surgical procedure. Common side effects include nausea, vomiting, abdominal pain, fatigue, fever, headache, dizziness, and diarrhea.

After the abortion, we'll give you written and verbal instructions for after-care. We'll also give you birth control if requested. No follow-up appointment is necessary although we will require the results of a pregnancy test to ensure the abortion is complete. Our staff is available twenty-four hours a day to answer any of your post-abortion questions or concerns.

Advantages and Disadvantages of Non-surgical Abortion

Women in the clinical trials cited several reasons for choosing non-surgical over surgical abortion, including avoiding surgery or anesthesia, greater privacy, a greater sense of control, and wanting a method that is "more natural, like a miscarriage." However, non-surgical abortion may require more visits to the clinic and may take several weeks to complete. If the method is unsuccessful, the woman will need to undergo a surgical abortion. Also, there are the side effects mentioned previously.
